Villains walk into rooms with certainty.

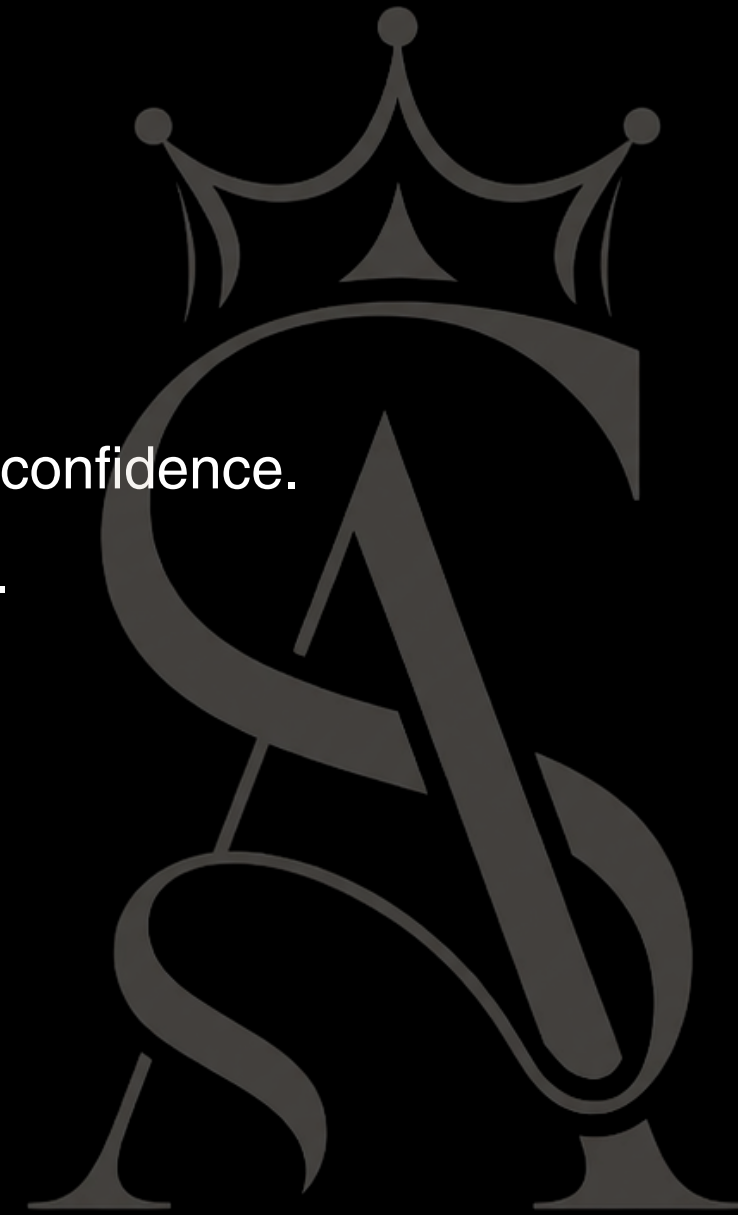
Not because of ego.
